REQUEST FOR LAWN MAINTENANCE

Request for bids for lawn maintenance at the Goodrich Cemetery located in the Village of Goodrich, where Seneca Street ends at 10165 Cemetery Street for the 2026 mowing season.

Bids may be split into two parts: lawn mowing and weed whipping/trimming.

Example: Mowing can take place at beginning of week and weed whipping within 5 days after mowing. There may be times that lawn mowing is the only service needed that week.

Lawn mowing will begin in May 2026 and continue into the fall season as weather determines.

Lawn will be cut to 2 ½ to 3-inch height.

Lawn mowing and weed whipping must be completed fully 3 days prior to the following holidays:

Mother's Day in May

Memorial Day in May

Father's Day in June

4th of July in July

Labor Day in September

The Goodrich Cemetery Board estimates approximately 10 +/- mowing and weed whipping events in the 2026 growing season. The number of mows/trimmings is determined by weather and vegetation growth.

Clear/clean up grass trimmings after each mow/weed trimming at: the main entrance, flag pole and mulched hill side area is required after each service. Any grass that is blown onto headstones during mowing or weed whipping must be cleared after serviced is rendered.

If selected, the service provider must provide proof of insurance and liability insurance naming the Goodrich Cemetery Association as a named additional insured and provide proof of workers compensation, if provider has employees or sub-contractors.
